Subject: Visitors in the Kitchen

Policy

Only Early Head Start Personnel with current Food Handler's cards are allowed in the kitchen on a regular basis.

Accident prevention is a priority in the management of food service operations.

Procedure

- 1. The Kitchen area will not be used as a traffic-way or meeting room for staff or visitors.
- 2. Visitors and staff other than food service staff are not allowed in the kitchen on a regular basis.
- 3. Children are not to be sent to the kitchen by themselves for any reason.
- 4. Early Head Start staff preparing food for a meeting may use the kitchen area, provided their Food Handler's card is current.
- 5. All facilities will have a first aid kit readily accessible and clearly marked for emergency use.
- 6. All staff handling food will have their current food handlers card posted at the site or in the kitchen.
- 7. Safety devices to cut foil and plastic wrap will be used to prevent injuries to staff.
- 8. At least three feet of walking space in the aisles and traffic ways are to be kept free of obstacles and obstructions.
- 9. Employees will be trained in the proper use of food service equipment in which it is required in their job duties.
- 10. Facility exits are clearly marked with visible EXIT signs.
